Current Dictionary entry

A frame-game format wherein for the first round (in singles) or for the first two rounds (in doubles) only scoring discs in the 10 count, for the second round(s) only scoring discs in an 8 count, and for the third round(s) only scoring discs in a 7 count. This sequence either repeats or reverses for any subsequent rounds. Scoring discs in the 10-Off count either always as minus 10 points for the color (e.g., a yellow disc in the 10-Off counts as minus 10 for yellow), or always as plus 10 points for the opposite color (e.g., a yellow disc in the 10-Off counts as plus 10 for black).
