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Current Dictionary entry

1. A variation of the mingle singles tournament format wherein the random draw for court, end, and color assignment for each player is done only once, at the start of the tournament. The players continue to play the same end and color for all games but change court each game by moving to the next court over, or if moving from the first or last of the courts, wrapping around to the furthest court (e.g., all players on Yellow move one court to their left and all players on Black move one court to their right). For each game, the total number of wins by the players of each of the two colors is recorded and accumulated. The tournament winners are all the players who played the color with the highest total game wins for the tournament. 2. MINGLE SINGLES.

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
