A fun-game format, played as singles or doubles, wherein a match consists of just one frame game, with a random draw for a new court and color assignment (and thereby a new partner in the case of doubles) for every participant each match. Sometimes players make a small wager (such as a dime or quarter) with their opponents on the outcome of a match.

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
