SHORT-GAME TOURNAMENT

Purpose: To practice end game strategy for the last thirty points of the standard 75-point tournament.

Game Format:

- Games to 30 points.
- Match consists of 4 games.
- Color is switched on each game.
- Tie games remain a tie.
- Points from each game are added to match total.
- Team with highest match total at the end of the four games wins the match.
- If the match total is tied at the end of the four games, lag for color, start at zero points and four ends are played (each player gets a hammer). If still tied, repeat changing colors each four-ends (no lag), until tie is broken.

Tournament Format:

- \$1 Entry Fee for Prize Pool
- Draw Doubles
- Three matches.
- Draw new partner each match.
- Carry-over # games won and match totals to tournament totals.
- Four cash winners - # of games won then points:
 - 1st, 2nd & 3rd receive 50%/30%/20%, less \$1
 - Last place receives \$1.
- Talking, coaching, & heckling during play is encouraged.
