1. A tournament format wherein players start out playing a series of singles games (hence "Singles") in a mingle singles format, with two separate divisions - one for men and one for women. When this portion of the tournament is complete, the top eight players from each division are combined for a draw doubles bracket competition, partnered by random draw in mixed partner teams of one man and one woman (hence "Mingle"), to play for the final four winning places. 2. A misnomer for "Mingle Singles".

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
