Sunday Morning Mingles @ St Pete

- Three games: Come late or leave early is fine. No obligation to play all three.
- Newbie/novice players should ask me for an intro lesson in place of first game. (Any player can benefit from this.)
- Line up along the fence for the chip draw each game for court assignment.
- Don't take your draw chip to the court.
- Courts are numbered at the tops of the scoreboards.
- Doubles unless all players on a court agree to Singles.
- 12 frames if Doubles, or 10 frames if Singles.
- If 3 players on a court: Odd player plays both ends for Doubles; or 3-Player Round Robin for Singles (play 12 ends).
- Practice: 4 discs for each player.
- Players on a court can switch ends or partners before game start.
- Ties are broken by 2-disc lag.
- If players at the receiving end disagree on a close disc, get a player from another court to make the decision.
- Game winners are entitled to an award sticker.
- 3-Game winners see me for a special prize.
- At the end of third game, erase your scoreboard completely; rack the discs & put them in front of the shed (not in the shed); return your chalk and eraser to the shed.
- Ask me if you have any questions about play or strategy.
- Coaching, heckling and having fun are encouraged.
