BETMAR/LAKELAND/ZEPHYRHILLS SUMMER SERIES SINGLE MINGLE RULES

Our intention is to provide summer tournaments for summer players from our participating clubs with minimal travel. All others are invited. Our goal is to have fun, enjoy the sport we all love and raise some money along the way.

Start time is 8:30 am with an entry fee of \$5.00.

\$1.00 of the entry fee and ½ the 50/50 money will go the hosting club.

METHOD OF PLAY

- 6-12 frame games or 75 points. Entering the tournament commits you to playing all 6 games. If you chose to leave or refuse to play without permission of the Tournament Manager, you will be subject to suspension from future tournaments in single mingles.
- 2 discs for speed and 4 discs for practice
- All 3 calls on the court to be made by other players still playing or players that have finished playing.
- 4 games will be played before lunch. A 20-minute lunch will be allowed from the time of the final match. Balance of games will be played after lunch.
- Blocks will be waxed at lunch.
- If a game is tied, there will be a 2-block lag by the players playing at the head, to determine the winner. The 1st block is for practice and the 2nd block counts.

RULES

- All amateurs and pro's will be drawing from the same bucket.
- Each player will draw a chip before each game. Exchanging chips is **not** allowed. The same partner and the same court may be drawn more than once.
- If you draw more than one chip, put all chips back and redraw.
- Players shall determine which member of the team will play at the head or the foot. The yellow chip decides first.
- A Bye chip will be used if there is an odd number of players or is there are more players than available courts. A bye will count as a win with 50 points allotted. If there are only 2 players on a court, the bye will be used as a pusher.

- If it rains and the Tournament Manager decides the court is affected, you will receive a bye-even if you have already received one. In a rain out, the winners will be decided by the last game everyone completed.
- Each player is responsible while for marking their winning score and the court number on the score sheet. Mark a "B" if you win with a bye.

PRIZE MONEY

- Prize money will be distributed using the established formula depending on the number of entries.
- Any sponsor money will be added to prize money.
- Any tournament expenses will be deducted from the prize money.

TOURNAMENT MANAGER

There will be a playing tournament manager and assisted by a committee. There will not be a tournament director. The tournament manager will conduct the opening ceremony and make any necessary decisions. The Tournament manager will handle all complaints and the manager's word is final.
