

USA NSA Disc Specifications - Reference Excerpt

A concise reference to the disc specifications stated in Section B - Equipment of the current USA NSA rules.

Specification	USA NSA requirement / reference
Diameter	6 inches.
Thickness	Not less than 9/16 inch and not more than 1 inch.
Minimum weight	Not less than 11 1/2 ounces.
New-disc weight	15 ounces.
Set	Eight discs comprise a set: four of one color and four of another; the rules identify yellow and black while allowing other color combinations.
Uniformity	Care should be taken that all discs in a set are uniform in weight and thickness.
Condition for play	Players are not required to play with discs that are not in satisfactory condition; defective discs may be replaced by good discs if available.

Notes

The current rules also state that new discs should not be used in tournament play unless thoroughly broken in. Reconditioning or repair can change disc characteristics; acceptance for a particular event remains subject to the governing rules and officials.
