

ADOPTED METHOD OF SCORING

(For all STATE and DISTRICT tournaments)

(Ad per: F.S.A. meeting of March 10th, 1984 at Sebring, FL)

In SINGLES, the TOP half of the scoreboard is to be used for scores when YELLOW is OUT. The BOTTOM half of the board is for when BLACK is out first:

Example:

7	8	}	YELLOW Out
14	8		
		}	BLACK Out

In DOUBLES, the TOP half of the scoreboard is to be used for YELLOW scores from BOTH ends of the court.

The BOTTOM half of the scoreboard is to be used for BLACK scores from BOTH ends of the court.

Example:

7	8	}	YELLOW Out
7	15		
15	15	}	BLACK Out
22	15		

In addition, MINUS scores on the board are to be CIRCLED.

EXAMPLE: 10^{or} 13
