Who can play in the Masters? The top 8 Pro ladies and top 8 Pro men Shuffleboard players in the State of Florida.

How is a Round Robin tournament played? Games are walking singles. Ladies and men have their own
Who won the Masters the most in consecutive years? Ladies division Mae Hall 7-1st in a row. In the division Webster Smith 4-1st in a row.

How does a player get to play in the Masters? During the regular season play, points are given in each tournament. The 8 ladies and the 8 men receiving the most points are then invited to play in the Masters.

How long has the Masters been played? The Masters started in 1960 and is the last tournament of the season.

Who sponsors the Masters? The first 5 years the Masters were sponsored by Joseph Y. Clancy. Since then by Harold & Beulah Dunbar. They have set up a trust fund to have the Masters run forever in their names.

How many different players have played in the Masters? There have been 56 ladies and 57 men.

Who won the Masters the most times? In the ladies division Mae Hall with 15. In the mens division Bob Litts and Jay Snoddy tied with 6.

Who won the Masters the most in consecutive years? Ladies division Mae Hall 7-1st in a row. In the mens division Webster Smith 4 1st in a row.

Who played in the Masters the most, with placements? Mae Hall with 15-1st, 5-2nds, 2-3rds for a total of 22 placements. Bill Folberth 1-1st, 7-2nds, 2-3rds, 3-4ths, 2-5ths, 1-6th, 1-7th for a total of 17 placements.

Who won the most games in the Masters? Mae Hall with a 19 won 2 loss record. Hans Strieb with 18 won 3 loss record.

Who won the lowest amount of games and still won? Mae Hall and Mary Moore tied with a 13-8 record. Mae Hall winner of play off. Bob Litts, Ernie Glenn and Farrell Bruner with a 12-9 record. Bob Litts winner of play off.



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
