(CODE OF ETHICS)

1. Encouragement will be given to new players interested in learning the game.
2. Efforts to defeat my opponents will be restricted to my shuffleboard strategy and the execution of my shots on the court.
3. Emotion will not be displayed on the court for my partner's poor play.
4. Criticism of my partner's opponent will not be made to my opponent.
5. Criticism from my partner will not be received without a negative emotional reaction.
6. Excuses will not be made for my own poor play.
7. Criticism of my partner's strategy or poor play will be made only to my partner and only in a constructive manner.
8. Recognition will be given to the winners of a match even if hard feelings exist.
9. Respect will be shown to tournament directors and referees at all times.
10. Appreciation will be shown to tournament host clubs.
11. Opportunities for the positive promotion of shuffleboard will always be seized.

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
